Athletes- This camp is for athletes ages 12 and older. Comprehensive coverage of the javelin will take place for all levels from beginner to advanced. The camp will take place at Hillsboro High School. It will include the latest technique, training, and drills necessary to develop future javelin champions. Please check in 10 minutes before the camp begins on the day of your session. If a coach would like to attend with their athlete the cost is \$100 per coach. Athletes are encouraged to bring their own javelins.

Todd Riech, formerly of Hot Springs, Montana is a current resident in Orange County, California. He was a member of the 1996 and 2000 USA Olympic Teams as well as World Championship Teams. Todd competed for the United States in the Pan-Am Games and competed in multiple USA National Championships. Before competing professionally he competed for Fresno State University where he was a NCAA Champion, 3-time Big West Conference Champion and remains the record holder at Fresno State University in the javelin. Todd was sponsored by both Nike and Powerade.

Brittany Borman, formerly of Festus, Missouri is a current resident in Orange County, California. She was a member of the 2012 and 2016 USA Olympic Teams as well as the 2013 and 2015 World Championship Teams. Before competing professionally she competed for UCLA and the University of Oklahoma where she was a 4-Time NCAA Champion, 4-time Big 12 Champion and remains the record holder at the University of Oklahoma in both the javelin and discus. Brittany is sponsored by Nike and the New York Athletic club.
